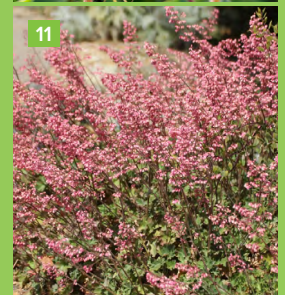
# NATIVE PLANTS














A native plant is a plant that naturally occurs in an area. This plant guide offers a list of California native and Santa Clarita Valley native plants to bring nature into your garden! By brightening up your landscape with natives, you'll save water, money, time, and add value to your landscapes by cultivating a colorful and healthy habitat for pollinators, including bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds. Not to mention, natives are already adapted to the local climate and soil conditions, and generally require less water and maintenance than turf grass.
