## **Rosedale Banking Program Background**

#### Banking Agreement Executed 2005

- Maximum 20,000 AFY put and take capacity
- Maximum 100,000 AF storage amount; 200,000 cumulative max
- Provides for construction of up to seven wells
- 2010 Operating Letter clarified recovery terms
- 2019 Dry-year Recovery Wells become operational
  - Six wells constructed in cooperation with IRWD (Three of seven wells constructed)
- 2020 recovery of 16,000 AF (14,400 AF of exchange water)
- 2021 recovery of 17,000 AF anticipated
- 2020 UWMP incorporates future construction of four remaining wells by 2030

### **USBR WaterSMART Drought Grant**

- Up to 50% matching funds for qualified costs
- Projects must be completed by 6/30/2025
- Application deadline 10/5/2021
- Requires Board resolution authorizing application, entering in to grant agreement and payment of matching funds by 11/4/2021
