Board Meeting to be Presented: July 19th, 2022

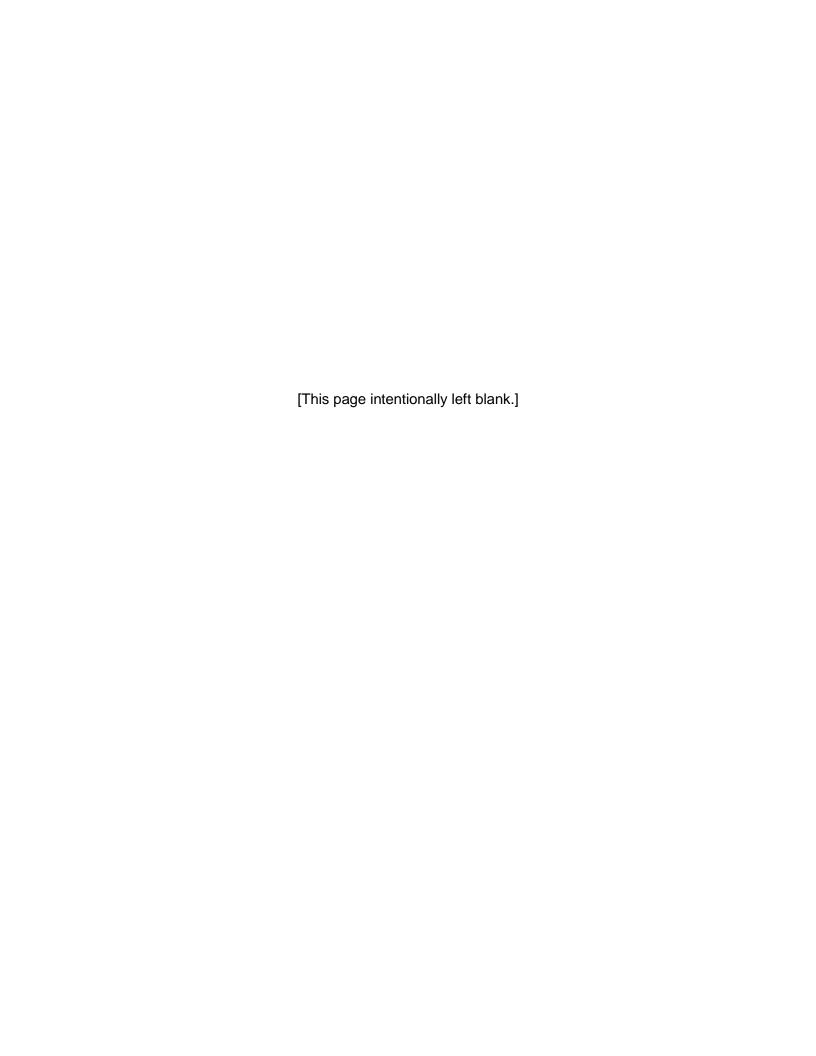

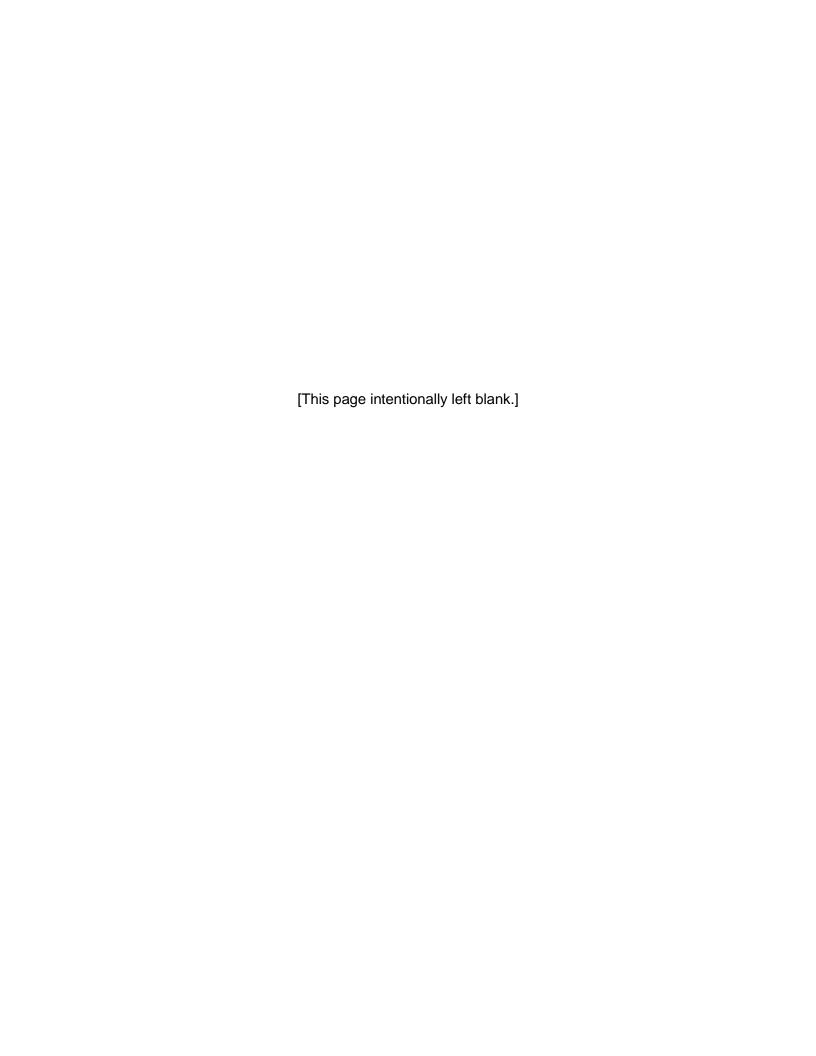



On July 6, I met with General Manager Matt Stone virtually via the Teams platform. We discussed a variety of issues related to SCV Water. I found the meeting to be open and productive, and I appreciate Mr. Stone's responsiveness to board member's desire for one-on-one dialog.

On July 7, I attended the VIA State of the State luncheon at the Hyatt Regency Valencia. The meeting featured a panel discussion with State Senator Scott Wilk and State Assembly Member Suzette Martinez Valladares, and was moderated by Ed Masterson. Senator Wilk and Assembly Member Valladares made opening remarks and then fielded questions from attendees that were submitted to VIA.
