About Water Shortage Contingency Planning

- Mission "Providing responsible water stewardship to ensure the Santa Clarita Valley has reliable supplies of high-quality water at a reasonable cost."
- Vision "Exemplary water management for a high quality of life in the Santa Clarita Valley."
- Values Integrity, Excellence, Safety, Innovation, Professionalism, Trust



About Water Shortage Contingency Planning

- **Provides** a detailed proposal for water supplier activity during a water shortage
- Prepares water suppliers for actual water shortage events
- **Recognizes** risks including drought, climate change, population growth, and catastrophic events
- Informs water supply mitigation projects, policies and programs
- Incorporates local conditions, constraints, and opportunities



About Water Shortage Contingency Planning

- Mandated in AB 1668 and SB 606 "Making Water Conservation a California Way of Life" (2018)
- **Required** as a separate planning documented approved by the SCV Water Board of Directors
- **Submitted** as an attachment to the 2020 Urban Water Management Plan
- Integrated for regional effectiveness and efficiency



Legacy Plan(s)

- Included as a chapter in 2015 Urban Water Management Plan
- Detailed 4 separate Water Shortage Contingency Plans
- Included varied number of water shortage stages (3-5)
- Detailed voluntary and mandatory water conservation measures
- Documented enforcement actions, penalties, and fees
- Assessed 3 catastrophic water shortage scenarios



Planning and Policy Updates

- Key water supply reliability attributes
- Six standard water shortage levels
- Synthesized water response actions
- Annual water supply and demand assessment procedures
- Communication and engagement protocols
- Monitoring and reporting procedures
- Reevaluation and improvement processes



Project Deliverables

- Water Shortage Contingency Plan
 - Evaluation, analysis, and response activities
- Demand Reduction Implementation Plan
 - Internal and external outputs
- Water Shortage Ordinance
 - Compliance, enforcement, and legal authorities
