### Points of Interest:

The highlight of this meeting was an update on the Salt and Nutrient Management Plan (SNMP,) which supports our recycled water projects. Based on the report, most water quality objectives will be met and most will improve based on GSA and SCV Water planned activities. The objectives in some areas are high due to "naturally occurring conditions" and the GSA board asked for additional information on a few points. The SNMP was originally done in 2016 and a more recent update was fairly minor. A much larger update is forthcoming.

In addition to other updates the board presidency shifted to Russ Bryden with LA County WW District 36 and board vice-presidency shifted to Gary Martin of SCV Water. The board has a pre-approved rotation in officers, though people can decline the rotation if they are too busy.

### Points of Interest:

Assemblymember Pilar Shiavo and a staff member met with Matt Stone, Steve Cole, Kathie Martin, Gary Martin and me for an introduction to the agency and issues of concern on 1/10/23. We met from 12:30-2:15. Ms. Shiavo was very interested in water issues and seemed a little disappointed we weren't going on an extensive walking tour...she was prepared to do so and pointed out her waterproof boots.

Matt Stone and Steve Cole gave overviews of the water agency and watershed. We viewed the treatment plant from the control room and heard from the lead operator on the basics of the plant operation. Gary Martin explained our long term water portfolio planning philosophy. We also talked about PFAS, Arundo, water efficiency, and state infrastructure like Sites, the Delta, and conveyance. Kathie Martin mentioned our Sacramento lobbyist Dennis Albiani as a good resource on water issues.
