
EWMD Program Overview & Qualifications

Overview

- Replaces standard fountain with a water bottle fill station
- Promotes quality and value of water
- Co-branded with agency and school
- Other high-use locations (mall, libraries, community centers; started at parks)

School Requirements

- Located in service area
- Highly visible public space for installation
- Maintain the fill station and signage for five years





EWMD's Responsibilities

- Agreement of terms and conditions for signature
- Approve proposed location
- Provide signage
- Provide and install the water bottle fill station
- Promote the water bottle fill station location on website





EWMD Program Features and Benefits

- Counts plastic water bottles saved from waste
- Easy maintenance; vandal-resistant
- Chilled water
- ADA and Division of the State of Architect (DSA) compliant



EWMD Program Cost/Funding

- About \$4000 per unit (half purchase, half installation)
- Capital funding viewed as a PR campaign, reaching next generation of consumers
- Started with minimum number of schools per year now seeking funding for all remaining schools upfront

Fill Station at Community Events: Overview & Logistics

- Brought to community events
- Hooked to potable water source using food-grade hose
- Porcelain sink with six faucets
- Giveaway: reusable water bottles
- Cost: Approx. \$1500; plus portable chiller
