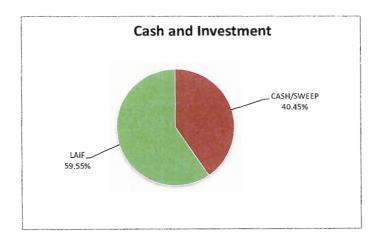

Budgets

SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION

Upper Santa Clara Valley Joint Powers Authority's (Authority) Biennial Budget covers fiscal years 2023/24 and 2024/25. The FY 2023/24 budget includes minimal interest income. There are no anticipated bond issuances during FY 2024/25.

The FY 2023/24 Budget includes \$75 million in new bond proceeds. The estimated revenues will be \$75 million plus minimal interest income. The estimated expenses will be \$75,000,000 as these funds will be transferred to an SCV Water Bond Proceeds fund. There will be an estimated \$4,500 in General & Administrative expenses, each fiscal year, to cover costs including ACWA Dues, ACWA/JPIA Insurance, etc.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The Authority will collect revenues equal to the amount of expenses.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Upper Santa Clara Valley Joint Powers Authority approves the attached resolution adopting the FY 2023/24 and FY 2024/25 Budgets.

RESOLUTION OF THE UPPER SANTA CLARA VALLEY JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY ADOPTING THE BUDGETS FOR FISCAL YEARS 2023/24 and 2024/25

WHEREAS, the Upper Santa Clara Valley Joint Powers Authority (Authority) adopts a Biennial Budget prior to the commencement of the next two fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has reviewed the Final FY 2023/24 and FY 2024/25 Budgets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Upper Santa Clara Valley Joint Powers Authority hereby:

- 1. Adopts as its FY 2023/24 and FY 2024/25 Budgets the attached Budgets.
- 2. Appropriates the FY 2023/24 Transfer Out and FY 2023/24 and FY 2024/25 Operating Expenses FY 2023/24 as shown in the attached Budget. The Authority does not anticipate issuing debt in FY 2024/25.
- 3. Authorizes the Executive Director to move operating appropriations from one-line item to another, provided that the total appropriation by fund is not changed.
