SUBJECT: February 14, 2024 Water Resources and Watershed Committee Meeting Recap

Report

The Water Resources and Watershed Committee met at 5:30 PM on Wednesday, February 14, 2024 at the Engineering Services Section (ESS) Boardroom located at 26521 Summit Circle, Santa Clarita, CA 91350. In attendance were Committee Chair Piotr Orzechowski, Directors William Cooper, Dirk Marks, and Gary Martin. Staff members present were Assistant General Manager Steve Cole, Director of Water Resources Ali Elhassan, Water Resources Planner Ernesto Velazquez, Executive Assistant Eunie Kang, and Information Technology Technician I Oliver Molina. Attending virtually was Sustainability Manager Matt Dickens, Senior Water Resources Planner Sarah Fleury, Senior Water Resources & Data Scientist Najwa Pitois, and members of the public were present. A copy of the agenda is attached.

Item 2: Public Comment – There was no public comment.

Item 3: Recommend Authorizing the General Manager to Enter into Contract with INTERA Incorporated for Groundwater Flow Model Improvement under the Water Resilience Initiative – After review and discussion, the Committee recommended through consensus to move this item forward for consideration and approval by the Board of Directors. This item will be presented in a separate report going to the February 20, 2024, regular Board meeting.

There was public comment on item 3.

Item 4.1: Status Groundwater Recharge Feasibility Study – Ernesto Velazquez gave a presentation on how SCV Water Agency can use local basin infiltration to enhance groundwater recharge. He shared his fieldwork results from Castaic and Pinetree and suggested further steps for engineering evaluation, water quality assessment, developing permitting strategies and conducting more modeling.

Item 4.2: Status of Water Supplies – Sarah Fleury gave an overview of the water supplies and availability. She compared the rainfall amounts in our Valley for 2023 and 2024 with the historical average. She also showed the snowpack levels across the state, the current reservoir status, and the changes to the 2024 operating plan.

Item 4.3: Director of Water Resources Staff Activities – Ali Elhassan shared that a new position for a Senior Hydrogeologist in the Water Resources Department has opened. He stated the recruitment process has begun, and we are looking for qualified candidates who can contribute to the Groundwater Sustainability Plan, Groundwater modeling and reduce our dependence on external consultants.

Item 5.1: Conservation Program Performance Overview – Matt Dickens provided an overview of the conservation program's progress. He discussed how the program achieved its conservation goals, what changes were made to improve the program, and what the regulatory implications were. He also shared the timeline for developing a long-term framework for conservation.

Item 5.2: Sustainability and Conservation Staff Activities – Matt Dickens reported on three important initiatives for Sustainability. He spoke on the photovoltaic assets, which are key for generating clean energy, and the Battery Storage Project, which aims to optimize the use of renewable sources and improve grid stability. Finally, the process of updating the Sustainability Plan, which includes a comprehensive assessment of our greenhouse gas emissions, quarry operations and other resource consumption patterns.

Item 6: Committee Planning Calendar – Staff and the Committee reviewed the Planning Calendar.

Item 7: Adjournment – The meeting adjourned at 7:00 P.M.
