

**Notice of Public Hearing Regarding Consideration of Recycled
Water Ordinance by the Santa Clarita Valley
Water Agency and Summary of Proposed Ordinance**

Notice is hereby given that on April 16, 2024, at 6:00 PM. at the Santa Clarita Valley Water Agency (SCV Water) offices located at 23780 Pine Street, Newhall, CA 91321, the Board of Directors of the SCV Water Agency will conduct a public hearing to consider the adoption of a Recycled Water Ordinance. At that time and place, any person interested may appear and be heard as to any matter regarding the proposed ordinance.

The purpose of the proposed Ordinance is to prevent the waste of potable water, promote the conservation and reuse of water resources, and to ensure maximum public benefit from the use of the Agency's potable and recycled water supply in accordance with applicable federal, state, and local requirements. Specifically, the proposed Ordinance encourages the use of recycled water and authorizes SCV Water to mandate the use of recycled water by existing and new customer in certain instances when it is available and can be provided at a reasonable cost. The proposed Ordinance provides for an appeal process and allows SCV Water to impose penalties for failure to comply with its requirements. The proposed Ordinance also allows customers to request conversion from potable to recycled water. The proposed Ordinance would go into effect immediately upon adoption.
