

## Urban Water Management Planning Act Requirements


- Updated every 5 years
- Reflect updated information
- Comply with Water Code revisions since previous Plan (2015)





### Water Code Revisions Since 2015

- UWMP submittal date (now July 1, 2021)
- Report compliance with SBx7-7 2020 targets
- Report compliance with the Water Loss Standard
- Drought Risk Assessment extended from 3- to 5-year duration
- Mandated Water Shortage Contingency Plan (WSCP) documentation and formal adoption through a public hearing process
- Water System Seismic Risk Assessment and Mitigation Plan
- Consistency/coordination with a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) or planning efforts
