Annexation Background

- 2006 CLWA adopts Annexation Policy
- 2007 CLWA approves form of annexation agreements
- 2007 SCV Water acquires 11,000 AFY from BV-RRB
 - 5,275 AFY for annexations
- 2013 Tesoro Annexation Agreement executed
 - 500 AFY of the BV-RRB water
- 2017 Tesoro Annexation Agreement amended
 - BV-RRB supply decreased to 389 AF

Annexation Background Cont.

- November 2018 County adopts final EIR for revised project
- August 2019 SCV Water Board adopts Resolution SCV-116 to prepare and submit LAFCO application
- October 2019 LAFCO application submitted for a change in organization (Annexation and SOI amendment)
- August 2020 County of Los Angeles Chief Executive Office request SCV Water Board of Directors to adopt the Joint Tax Transfer Resolution
