#### **SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION**

Upper Santa Clara Valley Joint Powers Authority's (Authority) biennial budget covers fiscal years 2021/22 and 2022/23. The FY 2021/22 budget includes minimal interest income. There are no anticipated bond issuances during FY 2021/22.

The FY 2022/23 budgets includes \$75 million in new bond proceeds, along with a bond refinancing of \$20 million. The estimated revenues will be \$95 million plus minimal interest income. The estimated expenses will be \$95,000,000 as these funds will be transferred to an SCV Water Bond Proceeds fund or used to pay off a prior SCV Water capital-project financing of \$20 million.

#### FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The Authority will collect revenues equal to the amount of expenses.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That the Upper Santa Clara Valley Joint Powers Authority approve the attached resolution adopting the FY 2021/22 Budget, the FY 2022/23 Budget and amending the FY 2021/21 Budget.


