
## Director AB 1234 Report April 18, 2023

## April 5, 2023, Team Building follow-up meeting with facilitator Erin Hastey.

I met with Team Building facilitator Erin Hastey on Zoom to receive and discuss comments and input she received from SCV Water directors on my performance as a director and as board president. I found the information very informative and helpful.

## April 11, 2023, Monthly meeting with Delta Conveyance Design & Construction Authority (DCA) Executive Director Graham Bradner.

I participated in my monthly one-on-one meeting DCA ED Graham Bradner. We discussed a range of topics related to progress on the DCA project, current and upcoming events. These meeting offer an opportunity to discuss issues of mutual interest in an informal and relaxed format. I found this meeting, like others held previously, very helpful in staying up to date on project activities of importance.

## April 14, 2023, Delta Conveyance Design & Construction Authority (DCA) Board Briefing.

The DCA Board Briefing is held to update 3 of the 7 DCA Directors on issues of importance. The following were discussion points of interest:

- DWR Environmental Manager Carolyn Buckman provided a brief update on status of the Draft EIR and permitting process for the project.
- Janet Barbieri and Tom Philp updated the group on public messaging for the project. Of particular note
  was a reminder that the project team will be holding a presentation at the Spring ACWA Conference in
  Monterey. The team will continue outreach efforts across the state. Messaging will transition from the
  term "climate change" to "weather extremes," as that is a more accurate description of effects on
  project design and benefits.
- Legal counsel Josh Nelson provided an update on efforts to obtain entry orders for locations where sub-surface investigations (soil borings) are planned for the rest of this year.
- Executive Director Graham Bradner presented an overview on the monthly report.
- Mr. Bradner provided a preview of the FY 23/24 budget which will be coming to the Board.
- An overview of the 4/20 Board agenda was provided.
