Background and Need

- SCV Water is expanding Spanish translation of outreach materials
- Other customers and community members may not be currently reached by SCV Water communication activities for reasons other than language barriers
- We need reliable communication channels with customers who are particularly vulnerable in event of potential water service and quality disruptions



Goal for Inclusive Engagement Assessment and Recommendations Project

Develop a foundation for SCV Water to conduct better informed inclusive engagement to reach all our customers, especially during potential service disruptions.



Expected Project Outcomes

- A better understanding of:
 - Demographics and community characteristics of SCV Water's service area
 - Vulnerable community members' communication challenges and strategies to offset challenges
 - SCV Water program managers' public communication needs, especially with vulnerable communities
 - State of California and other water agencies/managers' protocols for inclusive engagement
- A draft board resolution for inclusive engagement and initial actions for implementation
