SCV Water Invites Public Input on Urban Water Management Plan Update
Virtual Workshop to be Held March 22

Join the Santa Clarita Valley Water Agency (SCV Water) on Monday, March 22, 6:30–8:00 p.m., to learn about and provide input on our Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) Update. This will be the third Urban Water Management Plan virtual public workshop before the draft plan is made available for public review and comment. Workshop participants will learn about how this updated plan assesses long term water reliability through buildout (2050) and learn about the area’s seismic risk and the mitigation plan to ensure continued water supplies after disruptive and catastrophic events.
