## **SCV Water Bids Farewell to Long-Time Board Member Ed Colley**

*Colley Served Santa Clarita Community for More than Two Decades*

With the recent announcement of his pending move to Texas and resignation effective August 7, 2024, the SCV Water Board of Directors recognized Director Ed Colley for his nearly 22 years of service at their August 6 Board meeting. Colley served on the Board of Directors for both SCV Water and one of its legacy agencies, Castaic Lake Water Agency (CLWA).

“Ed’s knowledge, experience and passion will be dearly missed at SCV Water,” said General Manager Matt Stone. “He’s spent more than two decades committed to ensuring the residents of the Santa Clarita Valley have safe, clean water provided by a responsible, industry-leading Agency, and for that we will always be grateful.”

During the SCV Water Board meeting on August 6, Colley was recognized for his service to the community by each member of the Board. Offices of elected officials at the federal, state and local levels also praised and thanked Colley for his commitment to serving the Santa Clarita Valley as well.

Colley was elected to the CLWA Board of Directors in 2003 and continued in his position when SCV Water was formed on January 1, 2018. As a Director at SCV Water for Division 2, he most recently served on the Board’s Finance & Administration and Public Outreach & Legislation Committees, as well as on the Devil’s Den Water District Board of Directors.

A retired United States Air Force Captain, Colley served as a Space Systems Engineer including an assignment to Germany as the Senior Engineer for the European Space Systems Ground Site where he was awarded the Meritorious Service Medal. In addition, he is treasurer of Pleasantview Industries and serves as a peer mentor for the Tragedy Assistance Program for Survivors (T\*A\*P\*S).

Colley’s current term as Board Member was set to expire at the end of 2024 and his seat will appear on the ballot for the 2024 election on November 5. The SCV Water Board of Directors will discuss options for filling the vacant seat at its regular meeting scheduled for August 20, 2024.
